Band Council Report – Josh Attaway reported that the band council constitution was being worked on, that freshman representatives will be added to the council and that not much will be going on this summer related to the council.

Publicity/Website- Ray reported that he will be emailing the newsletter via email on Sunday instead of Monday to give everyone a greater chance to read it. We are up to 158 subscribers! All local radio stations and newspapers have been sent announcements with golf tournament details. KGOU will announce it for us. Way to go Ray!!!!

Fundraising-

- Sally Wojo has resigned as co-chair so Tracey Penka was elected as co-chair after a carried motion to allow the amendment of the constitution to elect another board member after the election month.
- Golf Tournament at Earlywine – June 23 at noon is T-time. Registration workers are already in place. Dave did 100 mailings and 100 emails inviting participants. So far we have \$1,450 in hole-sponsorships (tax deductible) and 5 teams. Various items have been donated. Hole-sponsors will be named on the website. Commissioner candidate Cosper has supported Band Boosters for years. Entry forms were plentiful at tonight's meeting!
- Band contest – Donna Kiper reported that 9/22/07 is taken so our final date is 10/6/07. Sponsors are being sought. Cleveland County will be doing food-handler classes again this summer at various locations.
- Joint-fundraising – Randy will send out the solicitation letter to Moore and S.W. OKC businesses.
- The idea of sharing a spaghetti fundraiser with Moore High has been tabled for a year.
- Concessions at football games were discussed and it was concluded that the best bet might be at junior high games. Also, the pee wee Jamboree might be a good opportunity for a cotton candy or snow cone stand.
- Outback Steakhouse – At the ice cream social in August, we will try to sell 100 \$15 tickets for a 9/8/07 (Sat.) meal at the 74th & May Outback. Sally Wojo will continue to organize this event for us.
- Cookbook – Jeanne has a target of 600 recipes and has about 175 now. If we set a deadline of the next booster meeting, we can have them printed by 8/18 (ice cream social).
- Tracey Penka discussed a Pampered Chef fundraiser to be held this summer. The profits can be added to the students' individual accounts. Tracey will discuss with Lupita Fernandez and try to obtain 100 catalogs.
- Jeannie proposed a "jail & bail" fundraiser to be held at a football game. It would cost \$5 to arrest someone and \$20 to make "bail". Advanced notice could be given to intended victims.

Uniforms – Jana will be training Tracey Leese to be the new uniform chairperson aka Uniform Nazi. All uniforms are clean and at the school.

Recruiting – Randy will be mailing a letter to 9th grade parents, addresses provided by Mrs. Bellows. Our mass mailing ability is good until October and we have stamps left over from the last mailing.

Band trailer needs – The trailer is in dire need of tires which are estimated to cost \$ 190; Chuck will call local tire vendors to see if any can be donated.

Director's Report – Mr. Westbrook reported that we have a good group this year. Mrs. Bellows, the director at West Jr. High has resigned. This position has not yet been filled. Also, the band room is in need of a television and video tape equipment. Donna Kiper will price both before the next meeting. St. Louis is approved. The music for this school year is "Belshazzar's Feast", an oratorio by William Walton.

Carpool possibility – With many parents who work full-time, it is a challenge to get one's student to the high school by 0800 and pick them up at noon. Ideas were tossed around to see how we can put parents into touch with each other to resolve this challenge.
