

Individual Student Fundraising

Some parents choose to write a check for the expenses associated with their child's participation in band. *These fees often include, yet are not limited to, creation of both drill and music; uniform maintenance; instrument maintenance; transportation to and from contests, as well as lodging for extended contest stays.* Others choose to participate in individual fundraising opportunities to cover some or all of these costs.

It is entirely up to each parent and child as to how many individual fundraisers they participate in. The Westmoore High School Band Boosters try to arrange a variety of opportunities for students throughout the year. This is done in an effort to appeal to a wider consumer market. Some examples include: Head Country Barbecue, magazines, Otis Spunkmeyer, Blue & Gold, poinsettias, Pampered Chef, as well as several other opportunities. Individuals earn either a percentage of product sales or a predetermined amount per item sold (depending on the fundraiser). Fundraiser monies are collected and turned in when the product orders are due. Once all monies are collected from the participating student and the products are delivered, the profits from each are credited to that individual student's account. Those funds are

for use exclusively by the individual student for the individual student's appropriate costs and expenses.

It is quite possible for a student to raise all of the funds required to participate in band.

30% of total **AVON** product sales

HEAD COUNTRY RIBS

Orders Due: Friday, **May 11th**

(Make checks payable to *Westmoore Band Boosters*)

Delivery: Week of **May 21st** (Before Memorial weekend)

Students receive:

.75¢ for each **pint** of barbecue sauce sold

\$5.00 for each **gallon** of sauce sold

\$5.00 for each **slab** of pork ribs sold
